2. Minutes of last Meeting

Resolved: Minutes of the All Purposes Committee held 11 October 2018 were agreed to be accurate record of the meeting, with a correction of numbering, signed by the meeting Chairman.

Public Participation – none present

3. Grant Applications

a) Chorley Couch to 5k

Resolved: Council agreed a grant for £190 for the purchase of hi-viz bibs and £300 for insurance.

b) Euxton Library

Resolved: Council agreed a grant for £100 as requested for speakers.

c) Remembrance Sunday

Resolved: Council agreed a grant of £125 to go to the youth band (as requested) for the Remembrance Sunday player.

d) Euxton Gala

Resolved: Council agreed a grant of £260 for gazebos.

4. Flower displays

Euxton Lane order changed to 3 square tubs and 4 barrier baskets, cost is £1469 plus delivery. The 3 Tubs would be rented, arrive planted and be taken away. The 4 Barriers would arrive planted and be ours to keep.

Bowling Green, 4 stone effect planters at a cost of £864 inc delivery

Progress the wicker roundabout project at £750, all fitting/fixings/planting is extra

Notice/map board/flower bed approved location on Brookwood Way, order Notice/map board with legs £658 inc delivery, wooden sleeper bed at a cost of £265 = total £923

Order banking bed on School Lane to a sleeper bed quote in £170

Bulbs – crocus/snow drops/daffodils for November planting. Chorley is giving us 500 Daffs, bulbs cost £382

Resolved: Council agreed to all these projects from the ‘Gardens/Planting/ budget.

Members discussed previously raised projects, and agreed to explore the project to improve the village centre area, first being the concrete fence in the dip, members will meet with the resident and if agreed work up a project to come back to committee.

5. ROF Lamp project update report and action to be taken

Resolved: Council agreed to this reclaim and restoration project of this heritage lam post, as detailed in the reports at a cost of £1500 for the restoration element.

6. Other items this Committee can discuss and/or take forward

Resolved: Council agreed to write to BAE or land owner to ask for any existing lamps and fire hydrants if they ever wanted to dispose of them.

An article could be written for the newsletter to ask if residents have any artefacts they wished to donate to a larger heritage project.

Pill boxes – could we request them to be listed. Research how to list heritage items.
